Acupuncture, massage, and other forms of body therapy are regaining popularity. More people realize that, rather than waiting until they are sick, they need to be proactive in their health care.

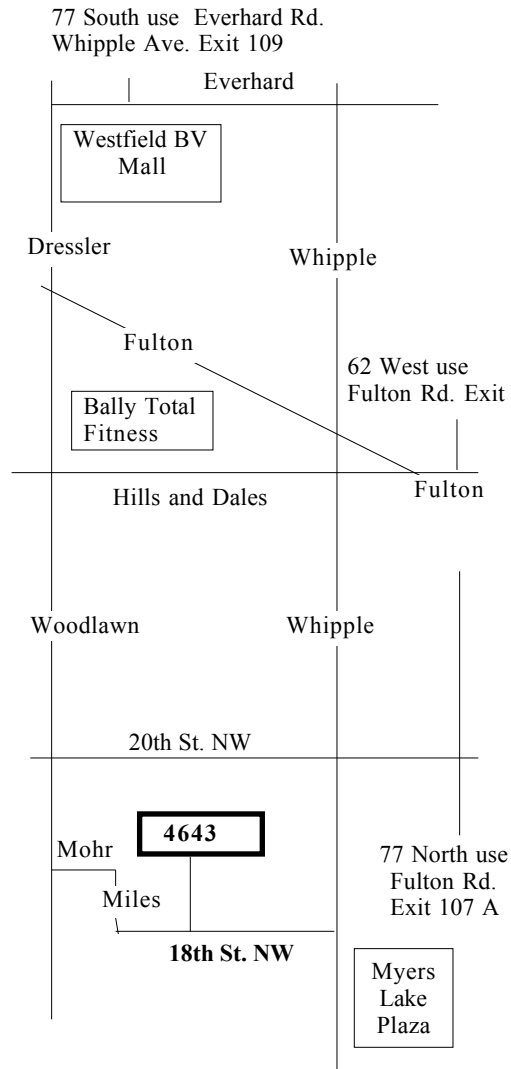
